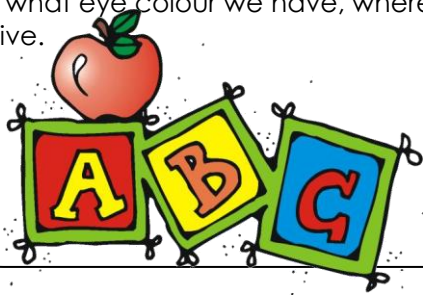
Themes:
